Call for External Evaluator

Project:

IDEA - Intersectoral Dialogue, Empowerment and Actions for Inclusion of Youth in Europe - which will be implemented between 1 March 2022 and 1 September 2024. The project was granted in the framework of the Call for Proposals in Erasmus+ KA220 – YOU – Cooperation partnerships in youth.

The project aims:

- establishing cross-sectoral inclusion networks to enable exchange of experience and good practice, thus strengthening the voice of inclusion youth groups and their organizations on national and international level. In non-formal youth work settings as well as in formal education settings. Development of practical guidelines on benefits of cross-sectoral cooperation, possible barriers and how to overcome them should empower the partners, their network, and organizations beyond the partnership to standardize this approach.
- developing cross-sectoral methodology: Exchange good practice youth inclusion methodology from different settings and adapt different methodologies to be applied in different youth inclusion settings, pilot them and draw conclusions to develop a comprehensive set of upscaled inclusive methods.
- more and differentiated visibility for inclusion in public discourse: Ensure visibility of inclusion youth groups and of the need for an inclusive society by improving communication about inclusion: young journalists and media representatives will be included in the project to raise awareness on the topic of inclusion if young people and organizations with inclusion groups are trained regarding external communication of the topic of inclusion.

The project is coordinated by **IZ - VEREIN ZUR FORDERUNG VON VIELFALT DIALOG UND BILDUNG**, the Austrian organization. **TENENET organization** is one of the project partners of the consortium and is responsible for the working package “**Evaluation of the project**”.

We are looking for **external evaluator** experienced in the fields of the Erasmus' NA's networking projects. The evaluator will act as a 'critical friend' to the project teams by compiling, exploring and evaluating the results of the projects.

The task of the external evaluation is to investigate, assess and evaluate the implementation of the project with specific reference to the following aspects:

- **Relevance and Quality of Design.** The appropriateness of project's objectives to the real problems, needs and priorities of its target groups/beneficiaries and the quality of the design through which these objectives are to be reached.

- **Efficiency of implementation.** How well means/inputs and activities were converted into outputs; Inter - partner communication, progress reporting and the sharing of information between teams.
- **Effectiveness of implementation.** The contribution made by the project's results/outcomes to the achievement of the project purpose (quality of results, outreach target groups, etc.)
- **Expected impact.** The project's likely contribution to the project's Overall Objective (to be assessed only during the final evaluation).

The budget for the external evaluation for the project is in total 2 800 euros.

Applications will be assessed and scored on the following criteria:

- Experience in Erasmus+: Youth In Action and other EU projects (40%)
- Experience in external evaluation (25%)
- Experience in the field of the projects (Youth, Human Rights; non-formal and Intercultural education and learning) (20%)
- Motivation (15%)

The working language will be **English**.
